Dear Elected Official:

The Northern Virginia Labor Federation, composed of nearly 35,000 members belonging to more than 55 affiliates, is proud to stand with our hardworking brothers and sisters who build our nation's airports' (including our own National and Dulles) runways and terminals, who prepare meals for travellers, who handled cargo, who keep terminals and aircraft clean, and who protect the public.

NoVA Labor joins the call on Congress to reduce the federal limitation on the Passenger Facility Charge (PFC). The PFC is a successful local program that airports need expanded to help keep infrastructure up to the demands of modern travel and to help get travellers' flights out on time. The federal government has not permitted a PFC increase in 15 years.

NoVA Labor believes airports should be able to set the PFC according to local needs.

New terminal facilities, new runways and other improvements sponsored by the PFC help U.S. airports compete in the global economy, which creates a better experience for passengers and good jobs for hardworking Americans.
