TIPPING GUIDE

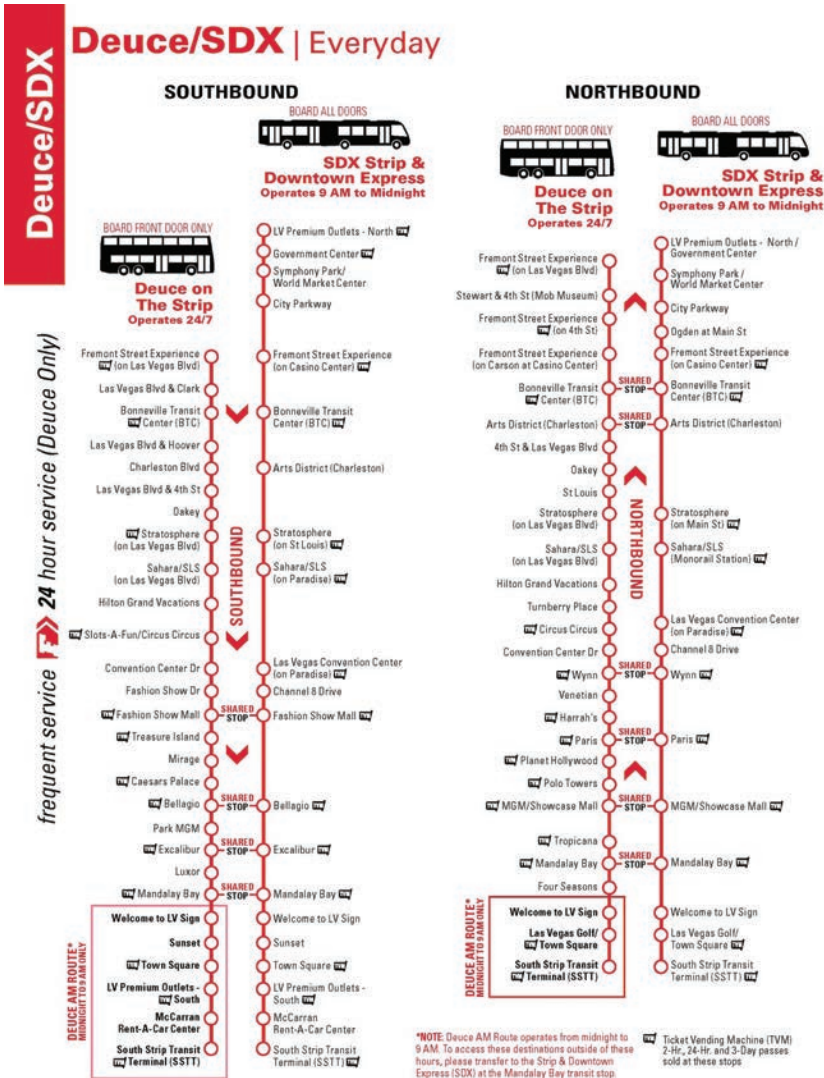
Housekeeper	\$5 minimum per day; leave a note so the housekeepers know it's for them; tip more for suites.
Bellman	\$3-\$5 per bag; tip higher end for heavy luggage (for check in and check out); \$20 for full bell cart
Server	20% of bill
Buffet Service/Banquet Server	10%
Bartender/ Cocktail Server	20% of tab
Valet	\$2-\$5; tip when car is returned
Shuttle Drivers	\$1-\$2 per person or \$4-\$5 per party
Taxis	15-20% of fare
Restroom Attendant	\$1-\$3
Skycap/Airport Bag Check In	\$5 per bag
Other Airport Assistance, e.g. pushing a wheelchair	\$5-\$10
Doorman	\$1-\$4 for carrying luggage; \$1-\$2 for hailing a cab; extra dollar if raining
Concierge	\$5-\$10 for tickets or restaurant reservations; \$15 for hard to get tickets or reservations
Delivery of Special Requests/ Items	\$2-\$5 per item
Room Service	20% of bill
Dealers	\$5/hour; can tip in chips
Slot Attendants (hand pays)	1%
Street Performers	\$1-\$2
Tour Guide	\$10-\$20
Front Desk	\$10-\$20 if they upgrade your room

2 a.m. to 7 a.m.	Approximately Every 20 Minutes

STRIP & DOWNTOWN EXPRESS (SDX) FREQUENCY

Operates 9 AM to midnight, everyday

Midnight to 9 a.m.	Does Not Operate - Use Deuce AM Route
9 a.m. to Midnight	Approximately Every 15 Minutes

First trips begin in each direction at 8:30 a.m. First trips may not reach middle of route until approximately 9 a.m. Last trips of the evening begin at midnight in each direction.

Strip & Downtown Express (SDX) service will start at 7 a.m. on days with major conventions at the Las Vegas Convention Center. Visit rtcnsv.com for more information.

Service along Grand Central Pkwy. ends at 10 p.m.

NOTE: Scheduled frequency is approximate and may vary due to unusual traffic conditions or other significant disruptions along the route.

LAS VEGAS MONORAIL

The Las Vegas Monorail has seven stations and travels the entire distance of the Las Vegas Strip. If you are staying at SLS, Westgate, Harrah's, The Linq, Flamingo, Caesar's Palace, Bally's, Paris, or MGM, you will be able to find a monorail stop at your hotel! Paper and mobile tickets are available, starting at \$5 for one ride and \$13 for a one-day pass.

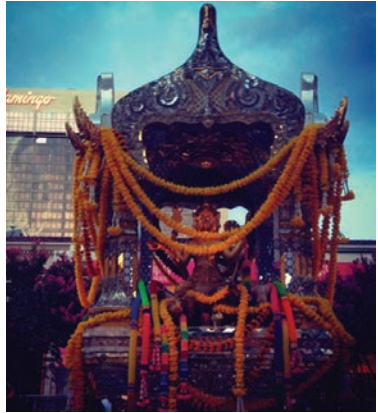
ATTRACTIONS AND MUSEUMS

Brahma Shrine at Caesars Palace

Open 24/7, every day. Incense, matches, and space to pray.

The Brahma Shrine is a replica of the famous Erawan Shrine in Bangkok, Thailand. The Hindu shrine is also known as the Thao Maha Phrom Shrine. The figure inside is Phra Phrom, the Thai representation of Brahma, the Hindu god of creation. The Brahma Shrine is one of five lucky spots at Caesar's for gamblers. The other four are the statues of Caesar Augustus, Joe Louis, and David and Cleopatra's Barge.

The Nevada State Museum and Historical Society opened on November 1982. The Museum collects, preserves, exhibits, and disseminates material that contributes to an understanding and appreciation of Nevada. The 70,000 square-foot Museum is located on the campus of the Springs Preserve.

Las Vegas Aviators

A Triple-A baseball stadium located in Downtown Summerlin community in Las Vegas. It is home to minor league baseball team the Las Vegas Aviators. It was completed in 2019 just in time for the team's first season. It has the largest video board in minor league baseball at 3,930 square feet. The stadium includes 22 suites, 400 club-level seats and 350 party deck seats, a center field pool, kids' zone, and several bars. GET OUTDOORS

Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area

Red Rock is one of Nevada's 23 State Parks. Located in the West end of the Las Vegas Valley, Red Rock offers 26 hiking trails, as well as a Scenic Drive. Entry is \$15 per vehicle.

Springs Preserve

The Springs Preserve has 180 acres of scenery, wildlife, exhibitions, and attractions including a museum, art exhibits, animal habitat, and even bike rentals for trail riding. Tickets start at \$18.95.

Valley of Fire

Valley of Fire is another Nevada State Park. Located about 50 miles northeast of Vegas, you will find red Aztec sandstone, petrified trees, and petroglyphs on this ancient land. Entry is \$10 and camping is \$20/night, plus \$10 if you want a site with utility hook-ups.



Hoover Dam

Open from 5am to 9pm, with tours from 9am to 5pm. Tickets to the power plant tour must be purchased in person, and are first come, first served. \$15 per adult. Call ahead to make sure tours are available, as the dam does close periodically.



GET OUTDOORS

Lake Mead National Recreation Area

Visit Lake Mead and go boating, biking, or backcountry camping. Entry to Lake Mead National Recreation Area is \$25 for a 7-day pass.

Extraterrestrial Highway

Open 24/7

The “Extraterrestrial Highway” is a 92-mile portion of State Route and is used to get to Area 51 and Rachel. Rachel is the closest city to Area 51 and is located 150 miles north from the Las Vegas Strip. There you can learn all about Area 51 and get breathtaking views of the Southwest desert.



GET OUTDOORS

Mount Charleston Lodge

Situated at 7,717 feet elevation at the top of the mountain in Kyle Canyon’s Humboldt Toiyabe National Forest. The lodge is right outside of Spring Mountains National Recreation Area, which has over 50 miles of marked trails over the rocky terrain. Weather is 20-30 degrees cooler than the Las Vegas valley. No hiking permits are required and there are no entrance fees.

Recreational marijuana is legal in Las Vegas. Cannabis dispensaries, which are cash only, are located across the Las Vegas valley. You must be 21 to purchase from dispensaries, and you cannot bring marijuana products on the airplane. If your employer administers drug tests, **use at your own risk**, as recreational marijuana is not legal nationwide. **Marijuana use is not permitted at MGM.**
