RE: No Political Contributions to 145 GOP Members of Congress


Dear Hospitality CEO:

On behalf of the 300,000 hard-working members of UNITE HERE and their families, I am writing to request that your companies' political action committees (PAC) refuse to make contributions to the **145** Republican Members of Congress who voted last week to overturn the results of the 2020 Presidential Election and attacked the heart of our American Democracy.

Our union and your company will always have our differences. Those differences are often stark and hotly debated. We resolve them through intense negotiations, picket lines, and petitioning our representatives in government, among other tactics. However, we always remain respectful of each other and certainly non-violent in resolving those differences. What happened last week in Washington was a stain on our history and the only way we can truly move forward is for the people responsible for inciting the seditious mob to face some meaningful consequences. A start on those meaningful consequences would be for these 145 Members of Congress to face diminished support for their dishonest and cowardly vote.

For the 145 Members of Congress who voted to subvert a free and fair Presidential election and gave the excuse that their constituents had "concerns" about the results of the election, I quote Senator Romney who implored his colleagues on the night of insurrection, "The best way we can show respect for the voters who are upset is by telling them the truth. That is the burden, and the duty, of leadership." Withholding political support from those 145 Members of Congress might encourage them to have those conversations with voters sooner rather than later.
